PRIVATE CELLARING – Your own private unit with 24/7 access



A self-storage plan, you keep your wine in your own private unit. You prefer having a physical connection to your wine. You enjoy the organizational tasks associated with this exciting hobby, and wish to remain “hands-on”. You take pride in your collection, and may showcase it friends now and then. You like to drop in at any time (unannounced) – to perform cellar management duties, and to confirm our cellar (and your wine) is in perfect order. You don’t want anyone to know what you have or your wine ever touched. In short – you want complete control, independence and privacy. Private Cellaring is the best plan if you require frequent access. Perhaps you only have a small wine fridge at home? Withdraw, deposit or visit your wine as often as you wish at no charge. Appointments are never required and access is 24/7/365.

With our elegant Tasting Room, some choose Private Cellaring solely for the unique entertainment possibilities. A visit to “Your Cellar” is a great way to start (or cap) an evening with friends, family or business colleagues. After a quick trip to your unit, you can take that nicely chilled gem and host an enjoyable evening in our fully-equipped Tasting Room and lounge.

After initial set-up (\$95), there is one flat monthly fee per unit. The units are locked, alarmed and monitored around-the-clock by a central monitoring station. A new lock is installed and you keep the key - so not even The Fine Wine Reserve can open your unit. Furnished with racking, display your bottles and enjoy all the benefits of a fully functioning wine cellar.

Please note that our private units are optimized for bottle storage. Although you may store cases in your unit, total bottle capacity will be reduced. Also, since we cannot access your wine, we won’t be able to provide you with some of our related services (e.g. pick-up, delivery, inventorying, etc.). Pick-up and delivery is only available when you move in or move out. If you require mostly case storage, and/or you will need our additional services, you may want to consider our Custodial Cellaring services (or divide up your collection into two accounts, with the most age-worthy product going to Custodial).

- Unlimited 24/7 access to your wine - no appointments required;
- One flat monthly fee, no handling, withdrawal, or bottle retrieval charges;
- Convenient drive-thru conveyor for effortless handling of cases between car and unit;
- Access to our private Tasting Room and lounge.

CUSTODIAL CELLARING - Bulk case storage with pick-up & delivery



Your wine is carefully inventoried into our Custodial Cellar, and pulled for pick-up or delivery upon request. Custodial Cellaring is for wine owners who prefer a “hands-off” approach to storing their wine. Typically, you have a large collection at home and only use us for your most valuable and/or excess product. Or you only need to “park” your wine during a moving event. For others it’s simply a time issue. You have no time to handle wine in and out of the facility.

Custodial Cellaring involves: 1) a monthly wine storage fee, and; 2) a one-time handling fee. The monthly storage fee is charged on a “per case” basis prorated to the day. The rate is the same for all plans, but varies according to case size (i.e. ½ case rate is less than full case), and volume (i.e. large volumes = lower rate). The handling fee is charged “per piece” upon deposit only. The amount varies according to the level of inventory/verification detail you require (see below). Keep in mind that you will not be able to physically access your wine. Access to the Custodial Cellar is strictly prohibited to all but senior Fine Wine Reserve staff.

There are four different “Plans” with Custodial Cellaring. Select the “**Bottle Inventory Plan**” if any of the following applies: 1) your storage need is longer term (generally >1 yr); 2) you want a detailed list of all your bottles – this list updated upon every deposit and withdrawal, and determinative of the actual wine you have on site; 2) you expect to make one or more withdrawals per year; 3) you may need to withdraw individual bottles, and/or; 4) you want FWR to take delivery of your new purchases - direct from the supplier or have us pick up your order from the LCBO. Those with a digital inventory of their wine may be eligible for our “**Bottle Inventory – No Verification Plan**”. Select the lower priced “**Box Inventory Plan**” or “**All-In /All-Out Plan**” if: 1) your needs are short term and/or you just want to “park” your wine with little or no withdrawal activity expected; 2) you will not withdraw individual bottles; and/or, 3) all new deposits will be made directly through you. Again, the monthly wine storage fee is the same for all plans.

- No need to ever visit the facility, we can take care of everything for you;
- No need to perform inventories, lug cases around, or handle wine in and out of the facility;
- More economical for those wanting to store all their wine “in the case”;
- Additional services available (e.g. delivery of new purchases direct to FWR, home delivery, inventorying, etc.).
