Since 1995, Pascal Lachaux, the late Robert Amoux's son in law, has been in charge of the famous estate in Vosne-Romanee. The domaine has been in the Amoux family for five generations. With holdings in some of Burgundy's greatest vineyards -- Romanee-St-Vivant, Clos Vougeot, Echezeaux, and Nuits-St-Georges and Vosne-Romanee Premiers Crus - Domaine Arnoux-Lachaux wines are among the finest expressions of these privileged terroirs.

The domaine has the unique advantage of having uniformly old vines in all of its parcels, making for a consistency of style. Lachaux has lowered yields and improved vinification and bottling methods. He usually employs a short pre-fermentation maceration and a longer cuvaison which he lovingly watches over, to use his expression. The wines are aged for 18 months in 20% to 100% (for the Grands Crus) new oak barrels from various suppliers. Lachaux aims for wines of great finesse and concentration, which reflect their respective terroirs

Under Pascal's stewardship, the domaine has initiated a policy of minimal intervention, with no fining or filtering, and an organic and biodynamic approach (he racks when the moon's descending, weeds when it's rising). The wines are highly sought-after and sold on a strict allocation from year to year.
